STEP DECK TRAILER



Step Deck trailers are primarily used to transport products that are too tall for a normal Flatbed trailer. There is an upper deck and a lower deck. The lower deck, called the well, allows for freight up to 120" high to be legally transported, while still providing the same loading/unloading capabilities of a standard Flatbed trailer. Specialized Low Pro Step Decks can manage freight that is up to approximately 126" to 128" in height.
