## STRAIGHT TRUCK TRAILER



Similar to Dry Vans as they allow for dock-level loading/unloading and protect product from the elements. The main difference is in the capacity. A Straight Truck is typically $20^{\prime}$ to $28^{\prime}$ in length which is ideal for picking up or delivering to locations where space is limited. Many Straight Trucks are equipped with Tailgates that allow for ground-level access where no dock is available.
